



Ocean Shores Police Informational Bulletin

The Ocean Shores Police Dept. was recently contacted by detectives from the St. John's County Sheriff's Office in Florida regarding a missing/endangered woman from their jurisdiction. Information was obtained that lead investigators to believe that a person of interest in the case may be in, or en route to, the Ocean Shores area in the woman's vehicle. The vehicle is a dark blue 2004 Toyota Rav4 with Florida license **Q662NJ**.

The woman pictured below is 45-year-old Brittany Tavar and is described as being 5'7" and 120 pounds. The male pictured below is Joseph Dean Roberts, a 26-year-old transient. He is described as 6'1" and 170 pounds. Roberts is being sought by law enforcement as a person of interest in connection with Brittany's disappearance. A nationwide alert has been issued.
